GOAL OF MEETING

UPCOMING

- November 10th, 2023
 - 10 Canadian athletes (2 Sanda athletes) are attending 16th National World Wushu Championships in Texas, USA.
 - 3 more spots available for male and female (Sanda)

OPERATIONAL PLAN

Training Camps and Competitions

- Taolu and Sanda 1 day to 1-week events
 - Development camps and programs for training to push athletes to competitive levels.
 - Scholarship events
 - High level competitions
- 3-4 training camps a year
 - With specific requirements
 - Camps athletes must qualify for
 - May be categorized by age group.
 - Some are open to all athletes and/or levels.
 - Difficultly movements
 - Physical training
 - High-level athletes to get together for team building national/international level.

- Get one in before end of 2023. (Possibly for November)

Certification courses

- Requirement to get NCCP certification within the next 2 years or asap.
 - We will bring in facilitators to operate.
- Goal for 2024 is to have a certain amount of NCCP coaches (level 2 certified)
- Level 1 certified coach:
 - Assisting, educating basic responsibilities
- Level 2 certified coach:
 - Teaching at a school, community centre
- Level 3
 - high performance coach level athletes
- Anything higher (National or Olympic coach)
- We want to support ppl going to these competitions athletes or coaches (we will look into it in the future) but you need ur certification (NCCP)
- Planning for November (Active start)

Judging Certification

- Our goal is to conduct certification courses either online or in person every 3 months.
- In the next two years we will have events for athletes as well as coaching and judging training events/courses

Events

- Broken down to club level events, provincial events, international events.
- We will create an event sanctioning page on the WushuOntario Website where those who would like to host an event can fill in the required fields (for example, How to host an event, Where do you want to host, What type, How many people in event, etc.) and we will work with you create an event template.
- An Ottawa event is our next goal (training camp and competition mix)
- Sanctioning policy (breakdown and outline in what you need to do to host and event) (if 2 or more WushuOntario schools: needs to be sanctioned event (tournament))
- 3-star or 2-star events
- To assist them in budgeting an event, always operate same cost.
 - 6-8 events per year (2 bigger events (provincial sanda event, April, August national event taolu and sanda event)
- 6 additional for different age groups, level and weight categories
- International (resort camp) competition/training camp (Mexico, Cancun) - Fun 1 week trip
